The practice is pleased to introduce Medicine Hub to you - www.medicinehub.org.uk - an online tool to help record antibiotic use in cattle and sheep. The initiative is widely supported by the livestock sector as a means of demonstrating responsible antibiotic use, as well being useful in managing the health and welfare of stock on your farm. Data can be uploaded directly onto the hub through a number of routes, one of the most straightforward being via the practice sharing medicine sales data. It is all stored securely and confidentially. Get in touch with the practice if you want to find out more. Ruminant producers are thought to be lower users of antibiotics than most other sectors, and by sharing medicines data with Medicine Hub - www.medicinehub.org.uk - we will be able to gather the evidence to prove this. At the same time, collating this information in an easily accessible format will mean we can refine medicine use as management decisions are being made based on recorded evidence. Ultimately, this will lead to improvements in animal health and protect the reputation of meat and milk to customers at home and overseas. The practice will share data through our practice management software with Medicine Hub; you simply have to authorise shared third party permissions. We have all heard a lot recently about antimicrobial resistance (AMR) and that the ruminant sector needs need to work towards meeting the reduction targets adopted by RUMA. Recording antibiotic data via Medicine Hub - www.medicinehub.org.uk will allow us to record medicine use in cattle, calves and sheep; information that will be invaluable in demonstrating how responsibly they are used. Medicine Hub is an online tool, developed on behalf of industry by AHDB and with support from processors, retailers, veterinary organisations and many more. The practice will soon be starting the process of uploading medicine sales data so watch out for a request for you to share third party permissions with us – allowing the practice full permission grants access to the vet to set up an account on your behalf and then upload and submit data.
